IF YOU NEED TO RESCHEDULE, YOU MUST NOTIFY ACCURATE RANGE 48 HOURS IN ADVANCE. FAILURE TO NOTIFY ACCURATE RANGE WILL RESULT IN THE DEFAULT OF \$150. TO RESCHEDULE YOU MUST CALL: 248-625-3551

OUR COURSE INCLUDES:

- Instruction by a Certified USCCA Instructor
- Guest Speaker: Law Enforcement Officer (Oakland County Sheriffs Dept. or Michigan State Police)
- All course materials
- Firearm and Ammunition for range qualification
- Everyone will use a .22LR caliber semi-auto handgun, that we will provide
- Snacks, Refreshments, Lunch
- A Certificate of Completion

THE DAY OF YOUR CLASS:

- If you have not shot at our range before, please visit our website www accuraterangellc.com to fill out our range wavier ahead of time.
 - On the home screen, there is a black box in the lower right hand corner that says "Sign our wavier". The completed form goes directly into our system.
- Please arrive by 9:45 am and check-in inside of the Accurate Range building.
- At check-in we will make sure you have a signed wavier on file.
- The only thing you will need to bring to class is your Driver's License.
- You may bring your own eye and ear protection, if you do not have any, it will be provided.
- NO personal firearms or ammunition allowed. All firearms and ammunition will be provided for certification.

AFTER YOUR CLASS:

- Take your course completion certificate to your County Clerk's Office. Your course completion certificate is valid for 5 years.
 - At the clerk's office you will complete a CPL Application, turn it in, and pay the application fee.
 - The clerk will then give you a receipt and direct you where to go to get fingerprinted. Once you get fingerprinted, the application process is complete.
 - The Michigan Sate police is in charge of issuing CPLs, they have 40 days to issue you the license.
 - You will receive your CPL in the mail, you can not carry concealed until you have received your license.
- If you ever have any questions regarding the CPL process or the laws, you can contact us at Accurate Range and we will pass your question along to one of our law enforcement resources. We are happy to help!
- The CPL class is not a marksmanship course. As an individual who is licensed to carry, it is your responsibility to train and stay proficient with your firearm handling and marksmanship. We hope that you will consider joining us for more training opportunities!
